New and Old Business

Adjourn to Contract Review Board Meeting to vote on sole source vendor and or need for competitive bids per legal notices given in Herald & News and Oregon State “Oregon Buys” posting. See attached.

No Spray List discussion: Letters were mailed out to all property owners and renters currently listed on the do not spray or treat list on July 5, 2023. Copy of the letter is attached for the official record. Responses received.

Approve rental agreement with the Chiloquin Fire District for a renewed rental agreement for Station#2. All terms and conditions remain the same as in previous years. Cost \$500.00 per year.

Discussion of accounting issues in Quick Books and need to find another accounting system as required by State law. The district finished FY 22-23 with a surplus of \$567.20. The \$2,500 grant to OIT 3RMVC was moved into the FY 23-24 to keep our books in balance under the old QB accounting system. The State auditors regularly have demanded a copy of our spending and budgeting reports. Data in QB is now corrupted. Program no longer useful. Chairman does not desire to contend with State auditors over budgeting issues and financial records keeping.

Discussion of light trap equipment usage, see attached mosquito complaint log reports as reference. Report on the new Ultra Violet light trap field operations. We have in inventory two operational CDC Light traps, One CO2 light trap, One UV Light trap supported by required batteries, battery chargers, and assorted spare parts. Estimated light trap equipment value \$4,400.

We have been using all of the light traps in July. We have successfully utilized this equipment to determine compliance with 3RMVC contract specifications. Provide assistance in the identification of insects. Provide assistant in the elimination of local mosquito issues where fogging is not legal, and assistance in removing foreign invasive dangerous insects (example the Red Wasp). Our traps have allowed the district to provide our taxpayers with solutions to mosquito issues that few districts provide. Per recent expert guidelines, it is advisable to trap for four(4) days in any given location. Therefore, we are upgrading our batteries to last four days in one location rather than one or two days.

Chairman has rewired all light traps due to sun exposure and wear causing short circuits. New equipment was rewired with 14 gage wire as the new equipment came with 24 gage wire. We have surveyors stands for three light traps as they are much easier to transport and store than the decade old plastic pipe stands. An old plastic pipe stand was converted to hold four light trap heads for storage. Batteries are now transported in correct size battery boxes for 32 AMP Hour batteries. Need to spend about \$300.00 more to replace collection traps with collection jars. The collection traps use a fine mesh and elastic lining that is constantly failing to maintain its fit and is hard to clean.

Chairman request the Board to consider purchasing the next generation mosquito UV insect trap; Mega Catch Pro 900 Ultra UV light trap system. System is programable to use light frequencies for species of insects we want to catch in the amount of \$1400.00. Money to come out of reserve account. Request this high-tech system to deal with citizen mosquito and insect complaints that cannot be resolved by fogging or standard light traps.

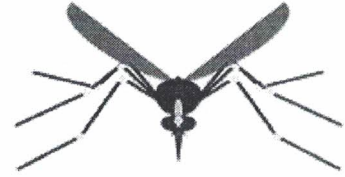

 \$61,000 per fiscal year or less than 86% of the
 estimated CVCD annual property tax revenues**

The CVCD Contract Review Board is seeking a determination that Three Rivers Mosquito and Vector Control, Mr. Ed Horvath Proprietor, located in Klamath County, Oregon is in fact a sole source vendor for mosquito control and general business services to the Chiloquin Vector Control District.

The CVCD welcomes qualified applicates to submit sealed proposal per ORS 279B.060 directed to the CVCD Contract Review Board, PO Box 860, Chiloquin Oregon, 97624 no later than Monday July 24, 2023, that will be opened in a regularly scheduled public meeting on Wednesday July 26, 2023 at 6:30 PM, at the Chiloquin Community Center Conference Room, 140 South 1st Street, Chiloquin Oregon. Proposals will be opened and reviewed by the Contract Review Board in public. Any person, organization, or corporation's proposals will be considered as a qualified bidder if they meet the following criteria.

- 1) The applicant and or applicators must be licensed in the State of Oregon as a **Public Health Applicator** and insured in an amount exceeding one million dollars of general liability.
- 2) The Applicant must prove that they have been in business for a period of more than five years providing mostly natural mosquito control services to government agencies.
- 3) The applicant must prove that they have a history of providing effective larviciding as the primary means of mosquito control.
- 4) The Applicant must prove they utilize modern computerized fogging control systems that record when, where, and quantity of fogging products applied.
- 5) The Applicant must prove knowledge of the breeding areas of mosquitos in the CVCD district. Examples: locations of ponds, pools, ditches, private water retention pools, and mosquito flyways, etc.
- 6) The Applicant must possess a valid FAA certification for flying agricultural drones.
- 7) The Applicant must prove that they possess agricultural drones capable of larviciding and fogging.
- 8) The Applicant must be willing to maintain a webpage similar to www.chiloquinmosquito.org as part of their contract agreement with the CVCD
- 9) The Applicant must be willing to attend CVCD board meetings while providing broadcast equipment for the public to view the CVCD board meetings on U-Tube.

In addition to the above listed requirements, the applicant(s) must prove they have a history of responding to mosquito complaints within 72 hours of receipt. The Applicant(s) must prove they have established a history of maintaining mosquito control in land mass exceeding 60 square miles. The applicant must submit proof that over the last five years, their mosquito control procedures have reduced the mosquito population to less than five mosquitos per hour as measured in CDC approved light traps that were located in populated areas with known mosquito issues.

Should the CVCD Contract Review Board find that no individual, organization, or corporation has responded to request for sealed proposals or that the individuals, organizations or corporations' proposals does not meet the above listed requirements, **Three Rivers Mosquito & Vector Control, Mr. Edward Horvath proprietor, who has meet all the above listed requirements, will be awarded the contract** to provide mosquito control and business services to the Chiloquin Vector Control District beginning in fiscal year July 1, 2024.

Should the CVCD Contract review Board find that other individuals, organizations or corporations meets our requirements, the CVCD Contract Review Board will ask for sealed bids from all interested parties before awarding a new five fiscal year mosquito control and business service contract. The CVCD contract review board reserves the right to reject any proposals or bids at its discretion and is under no obligation to award contracts to any person, organization, or corporation. 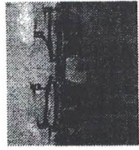
Notice to property owners or renters of requirements to remain on “DO NOT TREAT LIST”

The Board of Trustees of the Chiloquin Vector Control District request that property owners or renters who desire to remain on the District’s DO NOT SPRAY OR TREAT LIST contact the Vector District by utilizing our web page before August 30, 2023 and state an intention to remain active on the do not spray or treat list.

To remain on the do not treat or spray list go to www.chiloquinmosquito.org then mouse click the NO SPRAY box at the top of the page right hand side. A new screen will appear that states “NO SPRAY REQUEST”. Please fill in the boxes. All information is required if you want to remain on the do not spray list. You will receive a confirmation by email within 72 hours of your request. You may call 541 274 0132 and leave a message to request assistance to complete the form on line. The no spray form must be completed on line by means of a computer or cell telephone device to ensure accuracy of information.

The CVCD is one of a few vector districts in the nation that practices mostly all-natural mosquito control. We do not Fog or “Spray “unless requested by your neighbors then only if acceptable to CVCD policy (see attached) and justified in accordance with DEQ permit requirements. Attached is our chemical usage and spray policy information brochure for your review and consideration.

Chiloquin Vector Control District's Chemical & Application Policy

2023 – 2024 mosquito seasons

It is the policy and procedure of the CVCD to use the most environmentally friendly products available for public health protection. CVCD's contractors are required to utilize environmentally friendly pest control products whenever possible as the "first means" of controlling the mosquito population. Fogging is the district's last means of mosquito control. It is the policy of the CVCD to have our contractors engage in mosquito control by larviciding in the springtime to prevent a buildup of an adult mosquito population in the District. The policy of the CVCD District is to monitor the mosquito population by collecting larva samples or utilizing light traps to monitor mosquito populations. Our contractors are authorized to treat for mosquitoes if more than five mosquitoes an hour are found in a light trap. CVCD Contractors may treat an area for mosquito issues that are verified by mosquitoes' landings on the CVCD mosquito inspectors. The Chairman is authorized to utilize standard CDC light traps, our high-tech light/CO2 mosquito trap, or a ULV light trap at his discretion to help individual property owners experiencing mosquito issues.

District's Historical facts.

District was formed by the citizens of Chiloquin in 1969 due to complaints of mosquito infestation. District has approximately 69 square miles or 364,320 acres with a population of less than 3400 citizens. District operations have an economic effect on more than 500,000 visitors to local area attractions.

The CVCD has the smallest mosquito control budget in the State of Oregon and one of the lowest vector district operations budgets in America at \$58,350 for FY 2023 – 2024. The average annual mosquito control budget in the United States exceeds 1.5 million dollars per year for similar size areas.

The CVCD mosquito control budget for treating an acre of land equals approximately \$6.46 per acre. The average cost of treating an acre of land for mosquitos runs between \$250 and \$350 dollars per in acre in 2023.

Incidents of reported mosquito borne diseases in the CVCD equals “0” for 10 years. No other mosquito control district in the State of Oregon has been as successful as the CVCD in controlling mosquito populations and spread of mosquito borne diseases. No other vector district in Oregon has achieved this level of operational/cost efficiency.

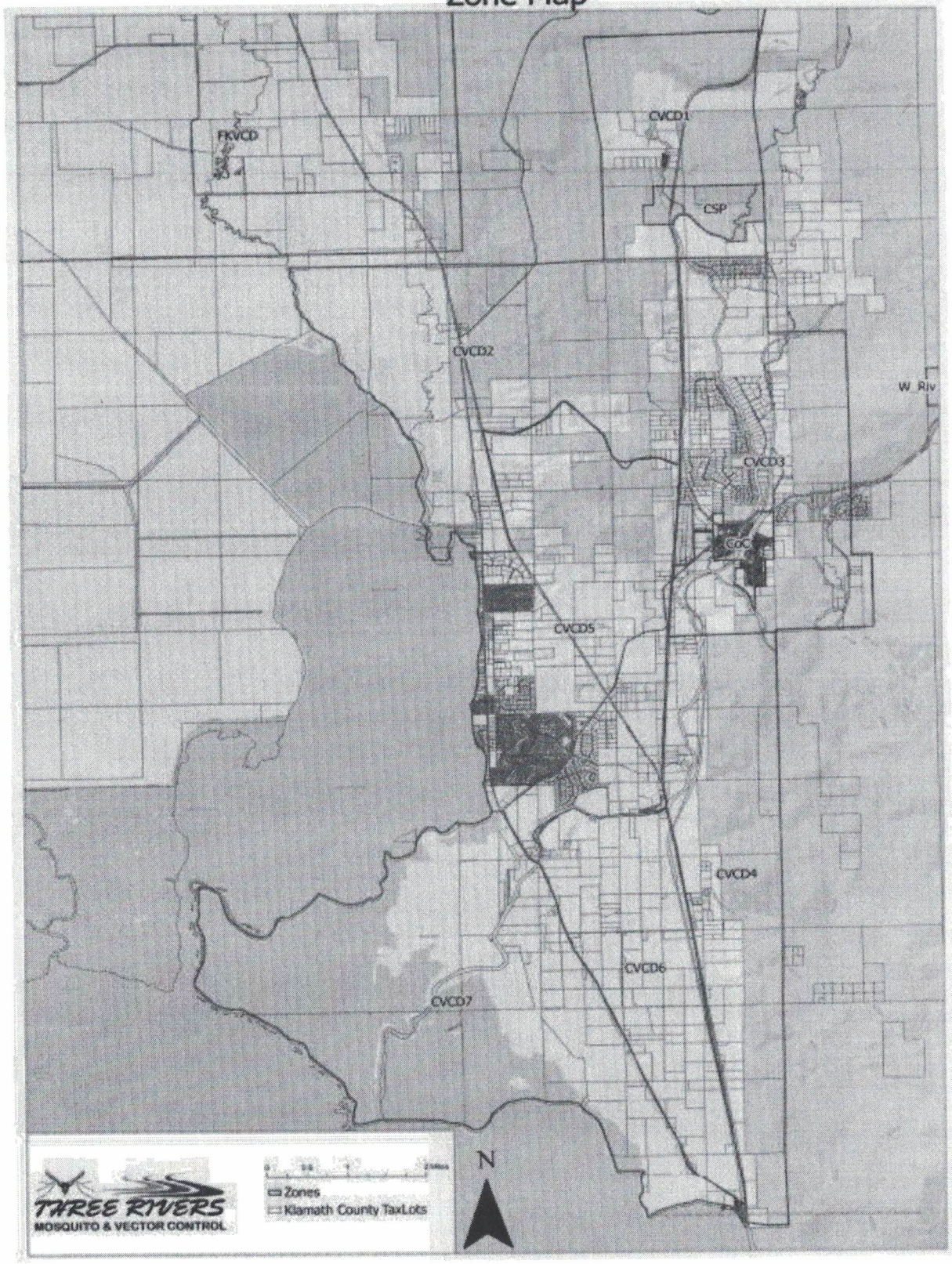

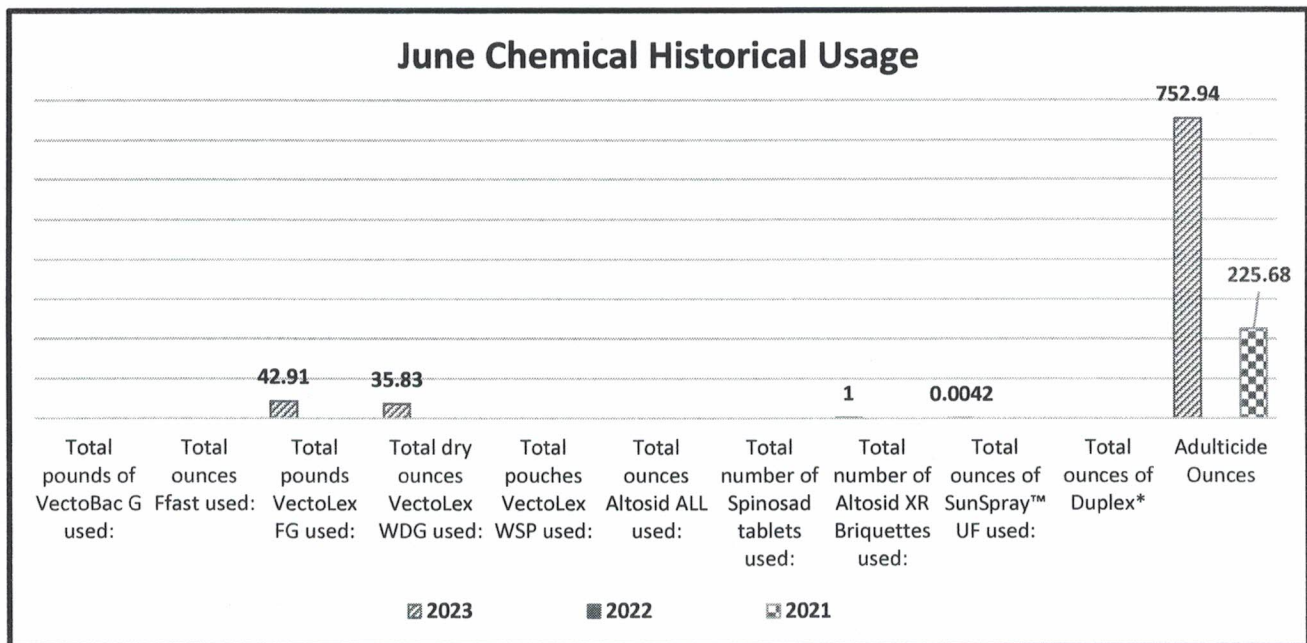

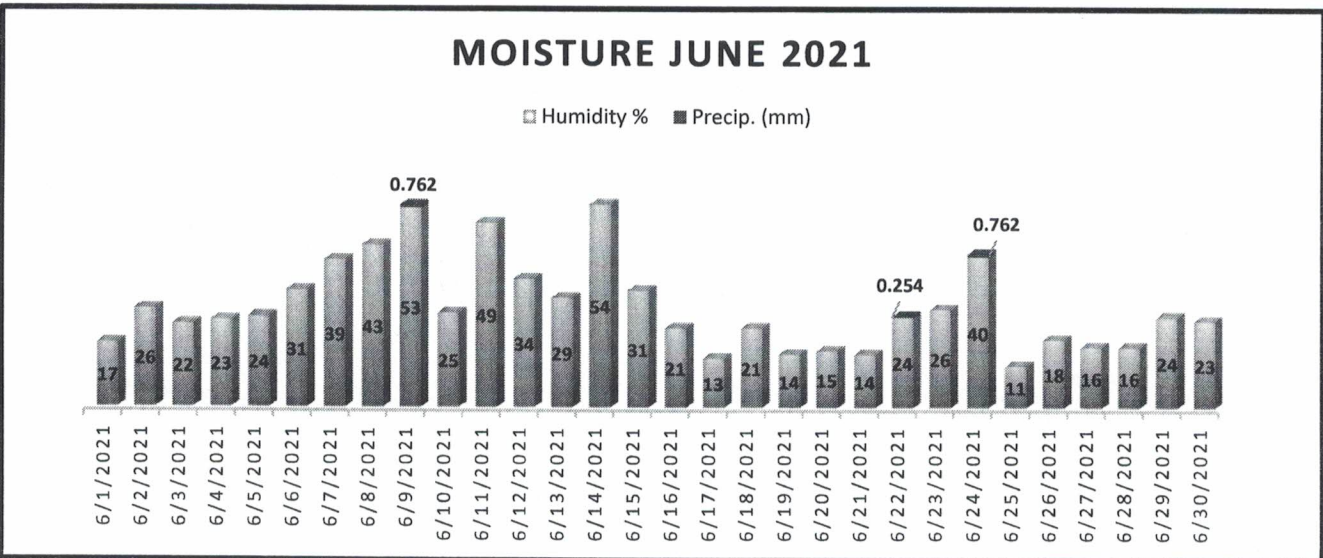
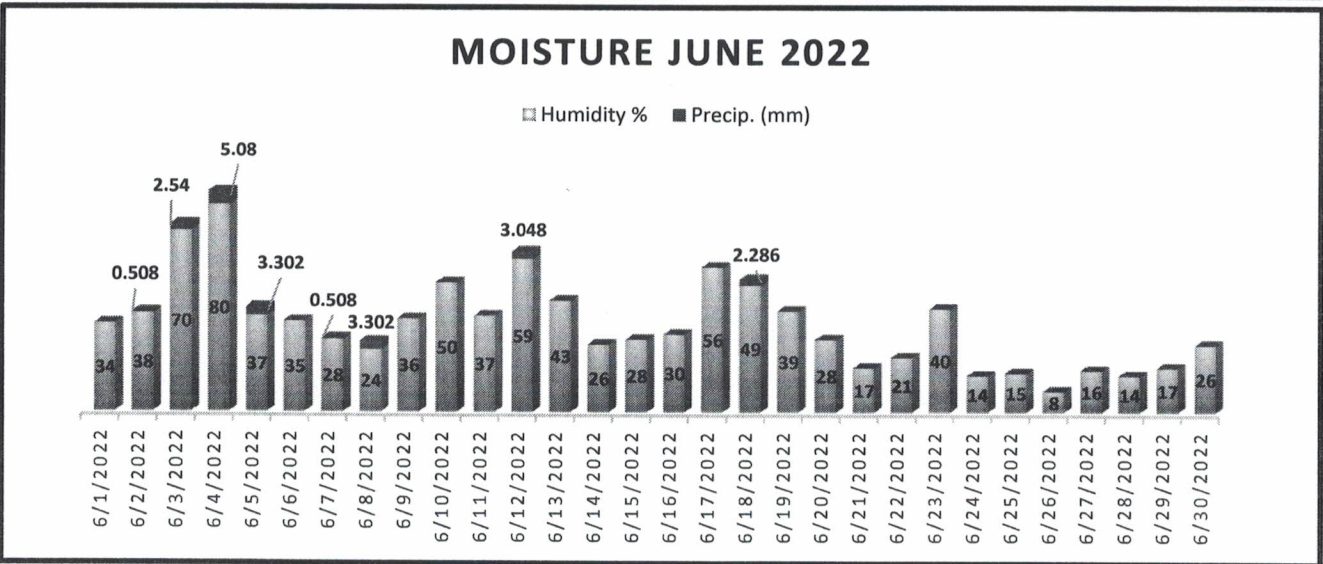
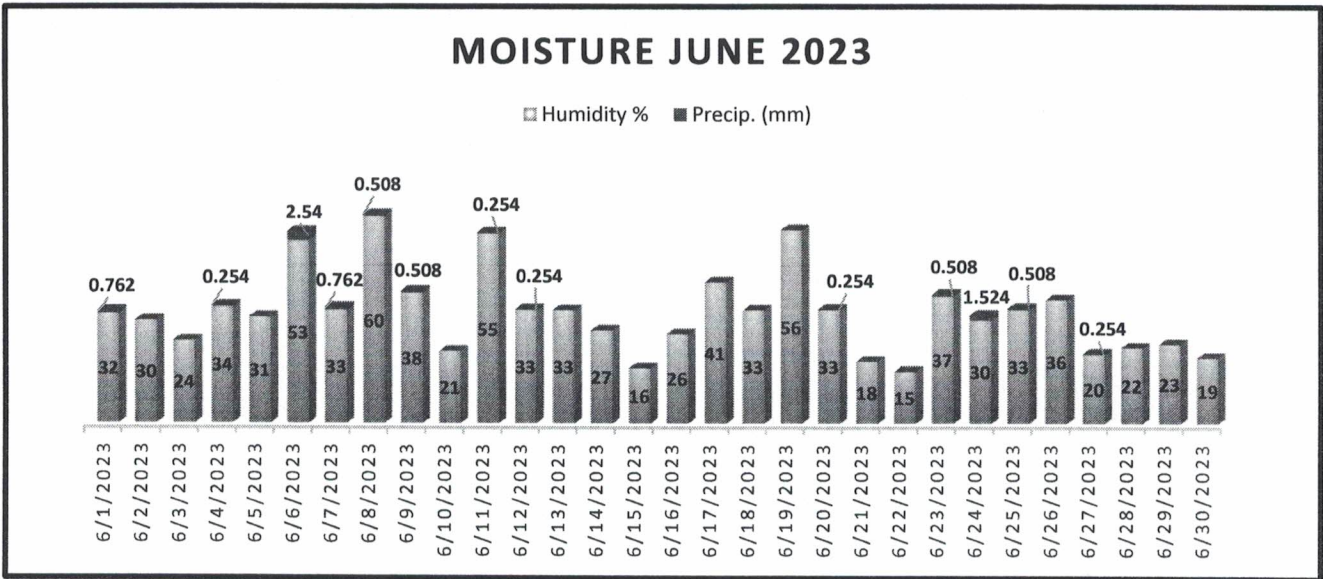
